1. The Retrieving Objects

Retrieving objects are the items the dog fetches during the test. These are brought to the test by the handler, although a club or testing organization may have a few extras on hand in case handlers have forgotten to bring theirs.

Balls and other retrieving objects provided by a club/judge should only be used for one dog.

The most common item to be retrieved in Novice and Intermediate is a tennis ball. The AKC Fetch Test rules says "a tennis ball or equivalent" because a similar ball may be used. In Advanced and Retriever, most handlers use retrieving bumpers (also called dummies).

Handlers should be sure to choose retrieving objects (balls, etc.) that are of a size dogs cannot choke on or swallow.





1. The Retrieving Objects

In addition to tennis balls, other retrieving objects may include:

- · ball on a rope. A ball on a rope may be used for all levels of Fetch.
- toy such as a Wubba toss-and-tug toy
- · retrieving bumpers (plastic or canvas).
- · Bumpers and toys may not be scented or filled with food.
- · Toys may be used in Novice and Intermediate AKC Fetch tests only.
- Dumbbells, gloves, stuffed animals, discs/Frisbees may not be used in AKC Fetch tests.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entries close at 6:00 p.m. on May 15, 2024, at the home of the Trial Secretary after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Hampton Roads Obedience Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Hampton Roads Obedience Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Hampton Roads Obedience Training Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

REFUNDS

PayPal entries will be refunded MINUS PayPal fees charged to the club

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive the run order. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Exhibitors MUST check-in for each test entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
