AKC Temperament Test (ATT) Entry Fees:

\$30 per dog for the first test, \$25 for the same dog's second test

ENTRY Submittal:

If entering by mail service (postal service, UPS, Express Mail, etc.):

- Make checks payable to Hampton Roads Obedience Training Club or HROTC

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Two legs, under two different judges, are required for the ATT Title.

The ATT is open to all dogs at least 12 months. They must be registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS Program, have a PAL number, or enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Qualifying Score: Qualifying Flat Ribbon

New Title: New Title Ribbon

AKC Temperament Test Title: If a dog passes the ATT on two occasions, under two different judges, the owner may apply for the AKC Temperament Test (ATT) suffix title by going online to www.akc.org/akctemptest and submitting the ATT title application along with the Evaluation Score Sheets (one from each of the two required tests) and the required title application fee. Upon verification, the ATT title will be applied to the dog's record and will appear on the dog's AKC title record. The title certificate will be mailed to the dog's primary owner of record.

Assignment of order:

Event Test 1 and Event Test 2 will be held one after the other. The test takes an average of six minutes. Eight dogs will be tested each hour for each event. Exhibitors will be assigned a time slot. Exhibitors entering more than one dog in an event will have their dogs separated by at least one dog, if possible (so there is time to put one dog away and retrieve the

other dog). Exhibitors may arrive up to 30 minutes before their assigned time slot. Run order will be emailed no later than 5 days prior to the event. Day-of-Test entries will be accepted for Test #2 **only**. These dogs will be added to the end of the trial after the pre-entered dogs with time slots have been tested.

Safety, Behavior and Liability: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all stations safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the test committee, be asked to leave the test site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. HROTC will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property. Additionally, HROTC assumes no responsibility for injury to children. HROTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against HROTC or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses: Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, martingales and body harnesses in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, head collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4 to 6 feet long. All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times.

Pet Waste: You must pick up and dispose of your dog's waste.

Refunds:

- No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from examination by the action of the Test Committee.
- Bitches in Season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the test secretary (Beverly McGhghy, email: bevmc8@verizon.net) no later than the day of the event
- Dogs pulled after closing (and before the test date) because of injury or other medical condition are eligible for a refund of 50% of their entry fee(s). Please provide a note from your veterinarian office with your refund request.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officials, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
